Personal data we process

Special and/or sensitive personal data we process

Our website and/or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are younger than 16 years of age, unless they have permission from a parent or guardian. However, we cannot verify whether a

The purpose for which we process personal data and the legal basis for doing so

Tyrrell Analytics processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- To be able to call or email you if this is necessary in order to carry out our services
- To offer you the possibility of creating an account

Automated decision-making

Tyrrell Analytics does not make decisions based on automated processing about matters that could have significant consequences for individuals.

How long we retain personal data

Tyrrell Analytics does not retain your personal data for longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected.

Sharing personal data with third parties

Tyrrell Analytics only provides data to third parties when this is necessary for the performance of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation.

Cookies, or similar technologies, that we use

Tyrrell Analytics only uses technical and functional cookies, as well as analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet, or smartphone when you first visit this website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and for your ease of use. They ensure that the website functions properly and remember, for example, your preference settings. They also enable us to optimize our website. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can remove any information previously stored via your browser settings.

Accessing, correcting, or deleting data

You have the right to access, correct, or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw any consent you may have given for data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Tyrrell Analytics, and you have the right to data portability. This means that you may submit a request to us to send the personal data we hold about you in a computer file to you or to another organization specified by you.

To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your proof of identity with the request. In this copy, please black out your photograph, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number, and Citizen Service Number / BSN. This is to protect your privacy. We will respond as quickly as possible, but within four weeks, to your request.
